

WGA Global Leaderboard Information

Leaderboard Purpose

The WGA leaderboard uses a points system to rank gymnasts. The ranking on the leaderboard will be used to determine eligibility for future in-person competitions. The higher you are any leaderboard, the more WGA-related opportunities will come your way.

Leaderboard Point System

Overall Leaderboard

The Overall Leaderboard is a combination of all points across each of the six events and all-around.

Nations Leaderboard

The Nations Leaderboard is a combination of all points earned by a specific country. As a bonus, the country that is in 1st place will have free registration for our next competition.

Leaderboard Updates

All leaderboard will be updated after every competition whether it is in-person or virtual. Note that this update will be made sometime within 48 hours after the competitions. Additionally, the date of when the leaderboard was last updated will be listed on the page.

Leaderboard Tiebreaker Rules

All tie-breaks will be determined by who submitted their routines earlier in the most recent virtual competition. If this does not apply, this rule then falls upon the previous competition, or the one before that, etc. Rules regarding tie-breaks for in-person competitions will be released once applicable.
